Rehab Display Contest Entry Form

A SPLASH OF SILVER

Repainting, Repurposing and Rehabbing village pieces have become a NEW and growing area with collectors over the past few years.

For the NCC's 25th Anniversary there will be a NEW, EXCITING, NEVER before done display contest for this craze. The Rehab Display Contest is simple, *A Splash of Silver*. Rehabbed pieces must be either repainted, added to or changed in some way with Silver—as little or as much as you want! Remember when getting inspired for your display that this is a milestone celebration!

Entries may be of any dimension as long as the display does not exceed 3 feet by 3 feet. There are no restrictions on height for the display. The display may contain a maximum of three (3) lighted houses which must be Department 56 and each have been rehabbed with the color silver. Accessories may come from other village manufactures, but the majority of the display pieces must be made by Department 56. Accessories can be rehabbed but it is not a requirement. It is important that the entry be newly created and has never been publicly displayed or judged.

Be sure to take pictures before rehabbing to include with your display showing other collectors what the village piece(s) looked like before they were redone. This is very important!

Pictures will be taken of each display and posted on the NCC website, Facebook page and in the *Club Connection*; it will include the winner's names and the NCC club they belong to.

If you would like to donate your display to be raffled off for charity please let us know.

DISPLAY PARAMETERS

Rules

- No more than three D56 building.
- As many accessories as you want, majority must be D56.
- Accessories can be rehabbed but it's not a requirement.
- Size may be up to 3 feet by 3 feet, any shape.
- No height restrictions.
- Must rehab buildings with the color silver.
- There is NO Club entry for this contest.
- Participants may enter only one display. The decision of the judges is final.
- Display must be new and never judged in any competition.
- Must include a "before" picture before rehabbing the buildings.

Awards

- Prizes will be awarded for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place.
- People's Choice Award of \$100.00 selected from all Rehab entries.

- *Village D-tails* will be used to determine the difference between a building and an accessory.
- **Electrical:** Display entrants are responsible for all extension cords and electrical wires.
- **Value:** Cost of the buildings, accessories and materials.

Independent Judges will be chosen and will use specific criteria to score each display. Scores will be tallied by two independent members of the Gathering Committee and the winners will be announced at breakfast on Sunday morning.
