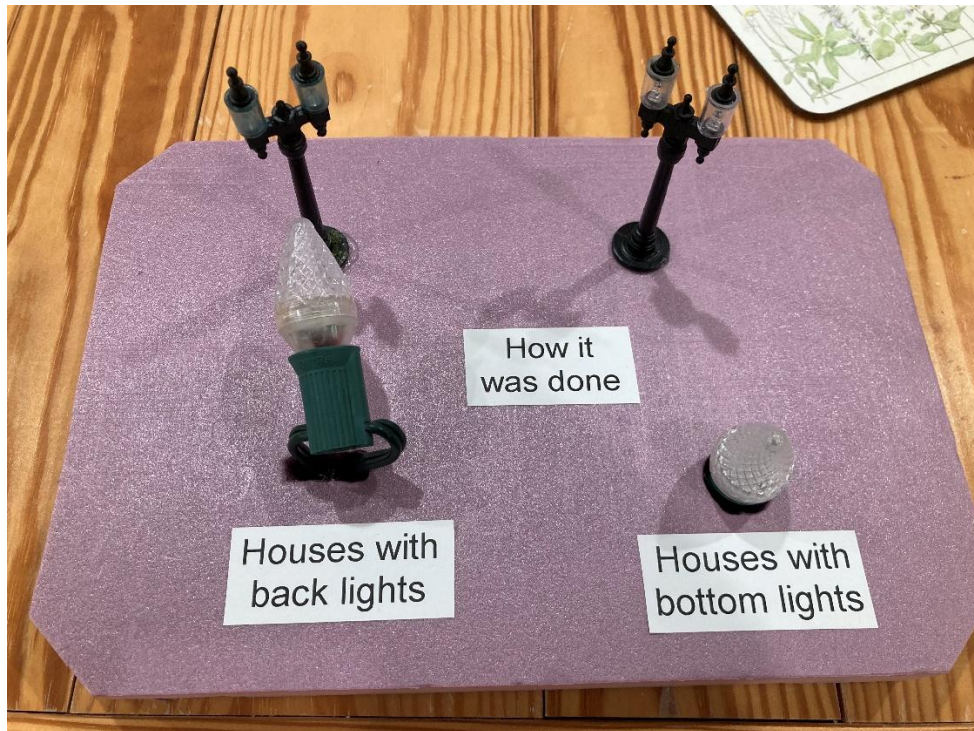
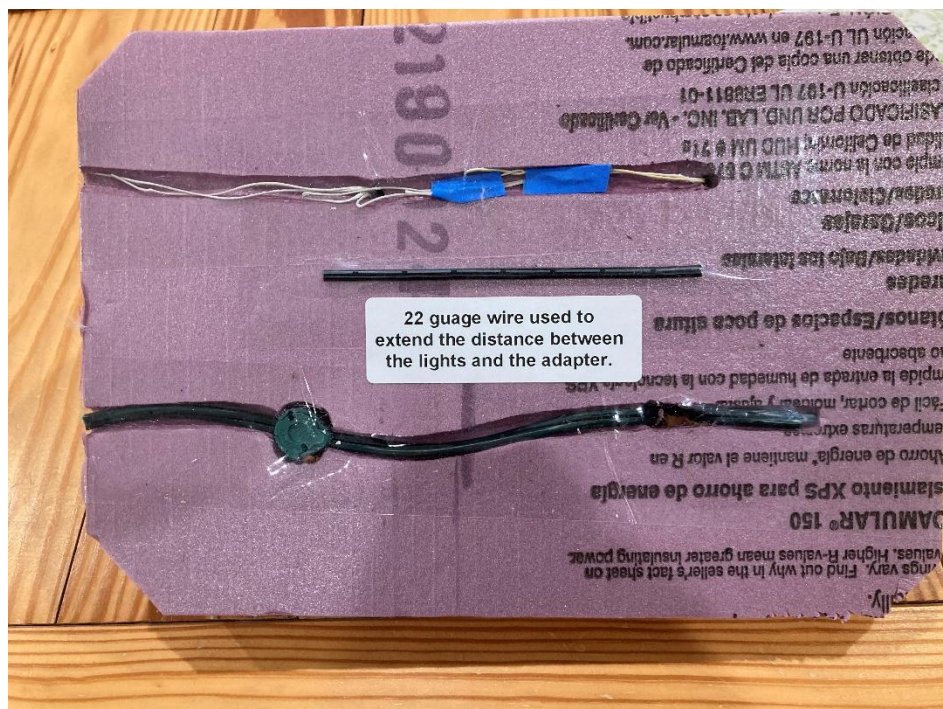


How I wire my displays



This a sample of the top of how I do my wiring.

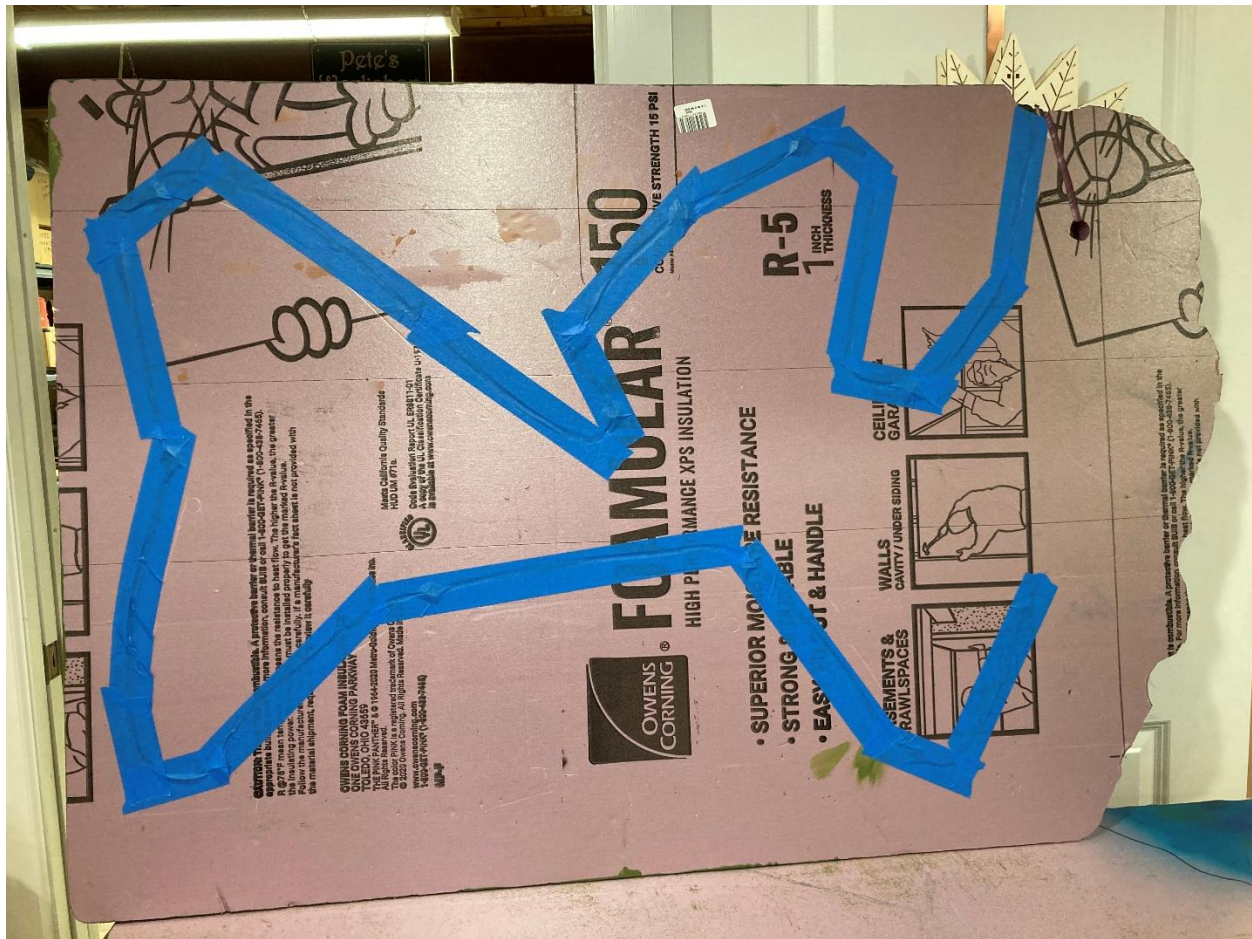


This a sample of the bottom of how I do my wiring.

Our Seasons Bay display



First I laid out the overall design of the finished layout. Then I placed the houses where I wanted them to be. The next step was to mark the position of the lights under or behind the houses. The next step is to use a hot wire tool to open the holes for the sockets to fit in.



Then I turn over the display and mark the route that the wire will take, using a hotwire tool to create a shallow trench between to holes for the lights. I then start clipping the sockets on the wire and inserting them from the bottom, I cover the wire with painter's tape. After I finish the wiring, I leave enough wire to reach the outlet and attach a plug.



I turn the display back over and add the light bulbs, I use LED bulbs.

I then add all of the houses and accessories, and the display is finished.
