

# Creating a Waterfall

Create a waterfall using items from around the house. To create the falling water:

1. Apply strip of clear package tape to cardboard.
2. Squeeze clear silicone caulk the length of your fall.
3. Use a spoon covered in soap to spread the caulk.



4. Use a fork to tease the end to create the splash at the bottom of the fall.
5. After it dries, apply white acrylic paint to enhance splash.
6. Use knife or razor to remove Fall from tape.
7. I used silicone caulking to apply the fall to my waterfall base.
